Point of care tools

<u>BMJ Best Practice</u> - A clinical decision support tool that brings together regularly updated research evidence with the knowledge of international experts. It offers a step by step approach to help manage patient diagnosis, prognosis, treatment and prevention. Watch an <u>introduction to BMJ</u> <u>Best Practice</u> (32 minute YouTube video)

<u>UpToDate</u> - A clinical support tool that includes a collection of medical and patient information and a number of medical calculators.

<u>British National Formulary (BNF)</u> and <u>British National Formulary for Children (BNFC)</u> - The BNF and BNF for Children provide UK health professionals with authoritative and practical information on the selection and use of medicines. Also available as an app for smartphones.

<u>NICE Guidance</u> - UK guidance which recommends the care and services suitable for most people with a specific condition or need, and people in particular circumstances or settings.

<u>CKS (Clinical Knowledge Summaries)</u> - Clinical Knowledge Summaries are short summaries of current evidence for primary care professionals. There are over 370 topics to choose from.
