Why does Postural Care matter?

Postural changes can have wide ranging impacts on the individual and the level of support they are needing. Postural changes can also be linked with pressure injuries. It is important the entire 24-hour time frame is carefully considered for an individual.

Meeting broad & complex needs

NHS England's Enhanced health in care homes framework (EHCH) states:

- care delivered will differ for each person and delivering holistic care requires strong clinical leadership and an appropriate MDT skill mix
- alongside the MDT, the wider primary, community and secondary care services adopt best practice in addressing the specific needs for the person receiving care

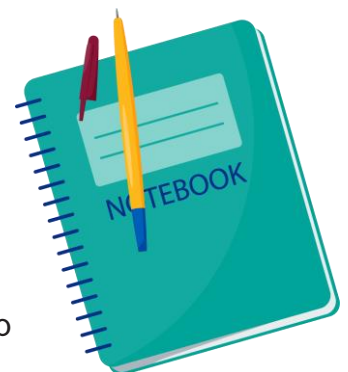
It is hoped in sharing these resources, that the needs of older adults living in residential care can be carefully and consistently met with evidence-based, person-centered collaborative care.
